Our Mission

Global Language Project (GLP) is an educational not-for-profit organization that equips disadvantaged public school students with the ability to speak a second language, giving them a measurable advantage as they enter the globalized world and workforce.

Our Work

GLP's first program launched in September 2009 at P.S. 368 Hamilton Heights School in Harlem, NY. The program currently serves 350 students and offers after-school language instruction in Mandarin Chinese, Spanish, and Arabic in Manhattan and Brooklyn.

GLP's Programs

- ***Speak To Succeed:*** A structured, after-school language curriculum teaching critical needs languages to underserved schoolchildren. The program serves students from kindergarten to fifth grade. Through *Speak to Succeed*, elementary school students will achieve fluency in a language other than English. The curriculum emphasizes traditional and experiential learning and was created by leading educational professionals from Columbia University and New York University (NYU).
- ***The Neighborhood Language Project:*** A partnership with local, multilingual businesses helping students practice the languages they are learning through field trips, presentations, and donations of materials.

Our History

GLP was founded by Angela Jackson, its founder and CEO. Nurtured by her experience traveling for work and living in France, Angela saw first-hand how the ability to speak more than one language opened doors for children abroad. Since then, Angela has made it her mission to start an innovative educational movement to help underserved schoolchildren benefit from the opportunities provided through language study, and founded Global Language Project in 2009.

Our Future

GLP is pursuing a rigorous growth strategy to expand the program with the intention of providing language instruction to over 6,500 students by 2015.
